

7 WAYS TO RECLAIM HIDDEN FLOOR SPACE

Are your operations suffering from space constraints? Do you have so many SKUs you're bursting at the seams? Has expansion or relocation crossed your mind? Think again!



Go Vertical

Take advantage of clear room height! Vertical Storage Systems can recover 50-85% of floor space, while improving inventory control, ergonomics and picking accuracy.

Store in Bulk

From Push Back Rack (storing loads up to 6 deep) to Automated Shuttle Systems (up to 37 deep), there's multiple ways to store bulk materials.

Reclaim Aisle Space

Aisles for pallet racking can be narrowed from 12' wide to as thin as 6' wide, and still be accessible by material handling equipment.

Raise your Production

Suspending production by overhead conveyor allows for space to be conserved for other business on the floor.

Build in a Mezzanine

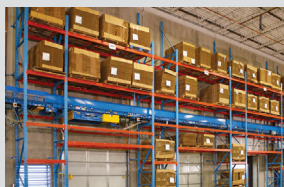
Free standing or rack-supported structures can double storage space, or increase workspace, without the need to pay additional property taxes.

Adopt an Inventory Management System

Tracking locations, life-cycle and cost of assets in real-time, helps with accurate stock replenishment. Proper inventory management helps improve space utilization.

Store Above the Door

Utilize open space above dock doors, by adding over dock pallet rack, for less frequently used items like paint, or cleaning supplies.
